Cost: \$1675 per semester.** This plan includes an unlimited number of all-you-care-to-eat meals during breakfast at the Wood Center and lunch and dinner at Lola Tilly Commons. It also includes \$75 in Munch Money, which can be used at all UAF dining locations campuswide. This plan does not include guest privileges.

_____ **Gold meal plan. Cost: \$1655 per semester.** This plan includes an unlimited number of all-you-care-to-eat meals during lunch and dinner at Lola Tilly Commons. It also includes \$100 in Munch Money, which can be used at all UAF dining locations campuswide. This plan does not include guest privileges.

_____ **Denali Block meal plan. Cost: \$1940 per semester.** This plan includes 250 all-you-care-to-eat meals during breakfast at the Wood Center and lunch and dinner at Lola Tilly Commons. The meal plan also includes the ability to exchange a meal in the equivalency of \$5 toward a meal at any other UAF Dining Services retail location, excluding Subway. It also includes \$200 in Munch Money, which can be used at all UAF dining locations campuswide.

_____ **Nanook Block meal plan. Cost: \$1975 per semester.** This plan includes 150 all-you-care-to-eat meals during breakfast at the Wood Center and lunch and dinner at Lola Tilly Commons. The meal plan also includes the ability to exchange a meal in the equivalency of \$5 toward a meal at any other UAF Dining Services retail location, excluding Subway. It also includes \$500 in Munch Money, which can be used at all UAF dining locations campuswide.

_____ **Upper Classman Block meal plan. Cost: \$945 per semester.** Enrollment is limited to juniors, seniors and graduate students. This plan includes 75 all-you-care-to-eat meals during breakfast at the Wood Center and lunch and dinner at Lola Tilly Commons. The meal plan also includes the ability to exchange a meal in the equivalency of \$5 toward a meal at any other UAF Dining Services retail location, excluding Subway. It also includes \$100 in Munch Money, which can be used at all UAF dining locations campuswide.

_____ **Chena Plan. Cost: \$1100 per semester.** Enrollment is limited to juniors, seniors and graduate students. This plan includes \$1100 in Munch Money that can be spent at any UAF dining location. Providing the maximum possible flexibility, there are no restrictions on which campus dining location it can be used at.

_____ **WCC Plan. Cost: \$600 per semester.** Enrollment is limited to Wickersham, Cutler and commuter students. This plan includes \$600 in Munch Money that can be spent at any UAF dining location. It provides a flexible way for students to participate in dining activities with friends on campus. \$600 in Munch Money allows for eating out during the semester, and gives students a break from cooking for themselves.

Fall 2011-Spring 2012 Dining Services Program Information

Participation in the food service program is required of all students living in university residence halls except for graduate students and students living in the Cutler Apartments (SAC). Your meal plan account is accessed by using your PolarExpress card and is nontransferable. Your PolarExpress card is required to enter Lola Tilly Commons and to use your meal plan or Munch Money at any UAF Dining Services locations and in most vending areas. **The meal plans are not active during winter or spring break.**

Fall Withdrawal Period

August 1 – August 26.... 90% refund of total semester board plan price.

October 18 - Nov 11 25% refund of total semester board plan price.

After November 11..... No refund will be given

The Fine Print

Terms:

The student is responsible for all terms of this agreement and as a participant in the board plan agrees to comply with all university rules, regulations, and policies.

The term of this agreement is for one academic year, beginning on the first day of fall semester and will conclude on the last day of spring semester. Changes to the board plan must be done in writing and submitted to the Dining Services/PolarExpress Office in 116 Eielson no later than the last day of fee payment each semester. Participation in the food service program is required of all students living in university residence halls except for graduate students and students living in the Cutler Apartments (SAC).

University Authority:

The university reserves the right to: 1) change the available meal plan options and associated costs after showing due diligence to inform board plan participants of the change, 2) terminate or temporarily cancel individual board plan privileges upon indication of non-payment of fees or misuse, and 3) close food service facilities for maintenance or an emergency with or without advance notice.

Refund/Pricing:

All board plan pricing is subject to change. Board plans are nontransferable and are not valid during winter break, spring break, or after the last day of finals in the spring. Board plan refunds are based on the above schedule. If the actual amount of the Munch Money used is greater than the Munch Money portion of the board plan refund, your refund will be the balance of the Munch Money account and the refund percentage of the meal plan.

Fall Semester

Meals begin on Aug. 28th and continue through dinner on Dec. 17th. Lola Tilly Commons and the Wood Center Food Court will be closed during winter break. Limited food service is available in Wood Center during winter break. Methods of payment include cash, check, BearBucks, Visa, MasterCard, or Munch Money.

Spring Semester

Meals begin with breakfast on Jan. 17th and continue through dinner on May 13th. Lola Tilly Commons and the Wood Center Food Court will be closed during spring break, March 10-18. Limited food service is available in Wood Center during spring break. Lola Tilly Commons reopens for dinner on March 18th and continues through dinner on May 13th. Methods of payment include cash, check, BearBucks, Visa, MasterCard, or Munch Money.

If you have already enrolled in the board program and wish to change plans, you will need to contact the Dining Services/PolarExpress Office in 116 Eielson to request a change. The last day to change a meal plan is: Sept. 9, 2011, for the fall 2011 semester, and Jan 27, 2012, for the spring 2012 semester.
